Prayer Teams

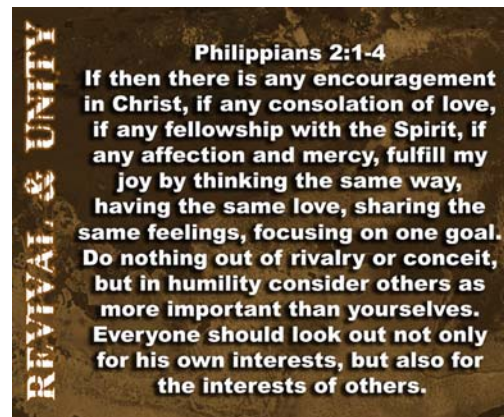
